Directions to the Mackie Building

Train to Redfern and Walk

1. Get out at Redfern Station.
2. At the station exit turn left and walk down Lawson Street. Turn left into Abercrombie Street. Cross the road and walk down Abercrombie to Shepherd St. Turn right into Shepherd St. Cross the road into the back of the university, near Civil Engineering.
3. Walk through the campus to City Road and cross into the main campus. Walk down Eastern Avenue and turn left into Science Road. The Great Hall is on your left.
4. Walk down Science Road till you come to the Holme Building, turn right and cross over the Footbridge to Arundel St. The Mackie Building is the first building on your left.
5. Enter through the first door and walk through to the Centre for Peace and Conflict Studies. The first white doors are shut but if you push them they open! Lesley's office is Room 110. Your classroom will be in the Mackie Building.

The walk from Redfern Station will take you from 15 to 20 minutes.

Train to Central and Walk

1. Get out at Central Station.
2. Walk through the Devonshire St tunnel till you come to the bus terminal, go left and walk down George St. till you pass City Rd.
3. Keep walking, with the university on your left, until you come to the Footbridge over Parramatta Rd. Walk up the first flight of stairs, turn right and walk over to Arundel St. The Mackie Building is the first building on your left.
4. Enter through the first door and walk through to the Centre for Peace and Conflict Studies. The first white doors are shut but if you push them they open! Lesley's office is Room 110. Your classroom will be in the Mackie Building.

Catch bus from George Street

1. The following buses go down Parramatta Road — 437, 438, 440, 480, 483, 461, 413, 435.
2. Get off the bus at the Footbridge Theatre.
3. Walk up the stairs and then cross the Footbridge into Glebe.
4. Turn left, and the first building on the left is the Mackie Building.
5. Enter through the first door and walk through to the Centre for Peace and Conflict Studies. The first white doors are shut but if you push them they open! Lesley's office is Room 110. Your classroom will be in the Mackie Building.

Car

1. You must **pay** for parking on the university grounds even on the weekend.
2. Try to find parking in Glebe or Forest Lodge.
3. There are parking inspectors patrolling the university all the time!
