## WHICH OPTION

- Conversation in class** – Join a discussion group, after or before a class in the Mackie Building once a week for an hour.
- Home Tutor** – Visit a refugee once a week for 1-2 hours in their home to help with their English. You will need to attend a one session a week course for 6 weeks with AMES to be eligible to join this program. Most refugees live in the Western Suburbs.
- Distance Learning** – We supply you with the text, match you with a student who you will call once a week. You will also need to correct written work they send to you (approx 3 hours commitment).
- Teach on-site class** – You must have TESOL training. Ring and discuss your ideas, proposal etc with co-ordinator.
- Fundraising** – Join a committee or organise some events to raise funds for resources needed to establish and continue the program.
