In accordance with the objectives of the Joint Committee, preference will be also be given to candidates intending to pursue a career in Jewish education at primary, secondary or tertiary level at an Australian educational institution. Applications from international students will also be considered.

The support offered will depend on the needs of successful applicants, taking into account tuition fees and other reasonable and necessary expenses, up to an amount of the order of \$1000 per semester or term.
