Through the generosity of the late Felicia Einhorn, the Joint Committee for Jewish Higher Education is able to offer a number of travel grants to support participation in and presentation of papers at international conferences in areas relevant to Modern or Classical Hebrew and Jewish Civilisation and Culture.

In accordance with the objectives of the Joint Committee, preference will be given to candidates pursuing or intending to pursue a career in Jewish education at primary, secondary or tertiary level at an Australian educational institution. Applications from international students will not be considered.

The support offered will depend on the needs of successful applicants, taking into account conference registration fees, travel and accommodation costs and other reasonable and necessary expenses, up to \$AU 2000 per conference per year.
