Explanatory Notes

Dean's Scholarship Fund

The *Dean's Scholarship Fund* was established early in 2007 in conjunction with a membership drive by the Arts Association undertaken with the support of Professor Stephen Garton, Dean of Arts, and the University Alumni Relations Office. To date we have received donations of \$2,200 to the scholarship fund. The fund will be used in the first instance to 'top up' a postgraduate research scholarship in the Faculty. Our hope is to build on this sum each year with a view to funding an annual research scholarship in the Faculty (currently around \$20,000). Your support would be greatly appreciated.

Donations of more than \$2 are tax-deductible.

Membership Fee now includes GST
